CAUTION: There are small components used in the construction of this unit. These loose items should be kept away from young children whilst assembling your unit to avoid the danger of choking hazards.




- Due to the size of this product we recommend that it is assembled in the room intended for use.

- DO NOT tighten screws until the product is fully assembled







WARNING - High beds and the upper bed of the bunk beds are not suitable for children under six years due to the risk of injury from falls.

WARNING - Bunk beds and high beds can present a serious risk of injury of strangulation if not use correctly. Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed to be used with the bed, for example, but not limited to ropes, strings, cords, hooks, belts and bags.

WARNING - Children can become trapped between the bed and the wall, a roof pitch, the ceiling, adjoining pieces of the furniture (e.g cupboard) and the like. To avoid risk of serious injury the distance between the top safety barrier and the adjoining structure shall not exceed 75mm or shall be more than 230mm.

WARNING - Do not use the bunk bed / high bed if any structural part is broken or missing.

- Always follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed. Always prohibit jumping on the bed.
- Prohibit more than one person on high bed and upper bunk.
- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the high bed and upper bunk.
- Ensure thickness of mattress below the mark that had been made at the entrance of the upper bunk.
- Ensure that ventilation of the room is necessary in order to keep the humidity low and to prevent mould in and around the bed.
- All assembly fastenings should always be tightened properly and that care should be taken that no fittings are loose.
